The agricultural export facility, operated by a major agricultural commodity processor and distributor, will construct two grain storage silos, make electrical service upgrades, and fund purchase of additional grain and cargo handling equipment to expand the capacity of the port to handle the movement of grain commodities. The project was awarded a \$9.3 million grant.
